

Wills

James Maw, Epworth 1826 (Will signed 12th March 1824)

Ref: Stow Wills 1825-27/129

".....I give and bequeath unto my sister **Hannah Post** and niece **Mary Maw**....."

"..... I give and bequeath unto my nephew **James Maw**, son of my late brother **George Maw** (2 acres of land in Belton)....."

".....I give and bequeath unto my nephew **James Post**....."

".....I give and bequeath unto my cousins **Mary Pettinger** widow of the late John Pettinger of Burnham and *Sarah the wife of Thomas James of Epworth*....." (not known how Sarah is related)

".....I give and bequeath unto **John Maw**, nephew, son of my late brother George....."

".....I give and bequeath unto my nephew **George Post**....."

".....I give and bequeath unto my niece **Ann Laughton**, wife of William Laughton.."

".....I give and bequeath unto **Elizabeth Sail** the wife of William Sail of Sykehouse, daughter of my late niece Hannah Ward....."

".....I give and bequeath unto **George Ward**, son of my late niece Hannah Maw.."

".....I give and bequeath unto **Hannah Ward** daughter of my late niece Hannah Maw..."

".....I give and bequeath unto my niece **Mary Maw**....."

".....I give and bequeath unto my sister **Hannah Post** and niece Mary Maw

Analysis:

- Parents are James Maw & Hannah Mason
- He is James Maw & Ann Peck
- He has a sister Hannah Maw & James Post; children are James, George, Ann & William Laughton
- He has a brother George Maw (deceased) with sons James, John and daughters Mary and Hannah & Ward (children George, Hannah, Elizabeth & William Sail)
- Furthermore he has cousins Mary Pettinger (Maw?) widow of the late John Pettinger of Burnham and *Sarah the wife of Thomas James of Epworth*
