## James Maw, Epworth 1826 (Will signed 12<sup>th</sup> March 1824)

"......I give and bequeath unto my sister Hannah Post and niece Mary Maw....."

"...... I give and bequeath unto my nephew **James Maw**, son of my late brother **George Maw** (2 acres of land in Belton)......."

"......I give and bequeath unto my nephew James Post......"

".....I give and bequeath unto my cousins **Mary Pettinger** widow of the late John Pettinger of Burnham and *Sarah the wife of Thomas James of Epworth*......" (not known how Sarah is related)

".....I give and bequeath unto John Maw, nephew, son of my late brother George....."

"......I give and bequeath unto my nephew George Post......"

"......I give and bequeath unto my niece Ann Laughton, wife of William Laughton.."

".....I give and bequeath unto **Elizabeth Sail** the wife of William Sail of Sykehouse, daughter of my late niece Hannah Ward......"

".....I give and bequeath unto George Ward, son of my late niece Hannah Maw.."

"......I give and bequeath unto Hannah Ward daughter of my late niece Hannah Maw..."

".....I give and bequeath unto my niece Mary Maw....."

".....I give and bequeath unto my sister Hannah Post and niece Mary Maw

## Analysis:

- Parents are James Maw & Hannah Mason

- He is James Maw & Ann Peck

- He has a sister Hannah Maw & James Post; children are James, George, Ann & William Laughton

- He has a brother George Maw (deceased) with sons James, John and daughters Mary and Hannah & Ward (children George, Hannah, Elizabeth & William Sail)

- Furthermore he has cousins Mary Pettinger (Maw?) widow of the late John Pettinger of Burnham and *Sarah the wife of Thomas James of Epworth*
