my sister forty shillings to be paid within one yeare after my decease Item I
give and bequeath unto Christopher Brown my brother five shillings
unto James Brown his sonn five shillings and unto Margaret Brown
Brown and Elizabeth Brown daughters of him two shillings and unto Alexander
Brown three shillings and my sonn I doe make my executor of this my last
will and Testament and my sonne Thomas Mawo to have the tuition of
him during his minority James Godfrey Elizabeth Godfrey his
sonne Story his daughter Thomas Dennyson

The fift day of September in the yeare of our Lord one thousand six hundred
fifty niner of Administration with this will annexed was granted to Thomas
Mawo Testamentary Executor and Guardian to Edward Mawo Minor named executor
