I Elizabeth Maroc of London a widow being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory (I thank be to God for the same) considering the certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof doe make and declare my last will and Testament in manner following (that is to say) - first and principally I commend my soul into the hands of Almighty God - my Creator and Creator trusting and assuredly believing that by and through the merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ I shall receive the free pardon of all my sins and life Everlasting in the world to come. my body I commit to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executor hereinafter named And as touching my Temporal Estate with which it shall please God to bless me I give and dispose thereof as followeth (viz) In primis I give and bequeath unto my dear wife Anne Plowman the summe of one hundred pounds and to my Godson Adam Plowman the summe of twenty pounds Item I give unto my Cousin Aethelred Holmes and Anne Holmes the summe of twenty pounds apiece To my Godson Thomas Browne the summe of ten pounds All which said several Legacies before mentioned my will is shall be paid at the end of twelve months next after my decease if my Executor can gett in money wherewith to discharge the same by that time Item I give unto my hood daughter in Law Anne Elizabeth a dowrie and give Sara Aeging Ten shillings a peire and to each of them a pair of sheets To Capt. Willinson and a wife Ten shillings a peire for Rings To my Cousin Isabella Jordan twenty shillings Item I give unto Aethelred Holmes the summe of five pounds if he gett in the money for my Executor which he hath lent for my Annuity upon and security As to my Linen and Plate my will is that the same be divided equally betwene me my Brother Aethelred John Aethelred and Cousin Plowman All the rest and residue of my Goods Chattells Debt ready money and Estate whosoever (my due Debt being first paid and all my charges discharged) I wholly give and bequeath unto my said Brother John Aethelred whome I doe hereby make and ordain and appoint sole Executor of this my will hereby Revoking and making void all former wills And I doe confirm this only to be my last will In witness whereof I the said Elizabeth Maroc have hereunto sett my hand and seal the three and Twentieth day of August Anno dñi 1706: Anno Regiae Annae 32^{ae} Eliz: Maroc.
